In order to run these programs successfully, we need the support and assistance of volunteers. Parents, grandparents, guardians, relatives and friends are encouraged to volunteer. There is something to suit the strengths, interests and schedules of everyone. We would love to have your help!

Volunteering is a great way to meet new friends, learn more about your child's school and show the children that you value education. Note that TB screening is required of all persons coming in contact with students on a regular basis, including volunteers. The District Office offers TB testing for anyone who has not been screened in the last four years. Testing dates will be announced, or you may choose to see your own doctor for testing.

Classroom Volunteering Volunteer positions in the classroom are coordinated by the classroom teachers. Examples of classroom volunteer opportunities include Room Parents, Gala Basket Coordinators, Rainy Day/Inside Recess Helpers, Meet the Masters assistants, Class Photographers, room volunteers, curriculum lab assistants and field trip supervisors.

PTA Volunteering

GENERAL HELP: Not ready to volunteer for a specific activity? *General Help* may be for you! Volunteers are needed to help with various jobs throughout the year, such as School Photos, Student Store, Accelerated Reader, Art Reflections, Community Partnerships, Hospitality, Kinder Coach, Marathon Kids, Staff Appreciation and Family Nights. Time requirement varies.

FALL FUNDRAISER: The fall fund-raiser is a catalog sale offering wrapping paper, gift and food items, etc. It is a great way to do your holiday shopping and support our PTA. Volunteers are needed to help collect, organize, count, and deliver orders in October and November. Time requirement: 1 to 4 hours one to four days, during school hours.

BOOK FAIR: This is an exciting event held in December during Conference Week. Books for all grade levels are available, as well as posters, gift items and software. Proceeds support the general PTA-sponsored programs as well as book awards for "No TV Week" and the Accelerated Reader Program. Volunteers help with set-up, take-down or working a shift on the sales floor. Time requirement: 1-4 hours during Conference Week.

SPRING FUNDRAISER: The annual fundraising gala needs your creativity and enthusiasm! Many volunteers are needed for this exciting evening, which is our biggest fundraiser of the year. Time requirement varies.

FAMILY FUN WALK/RUN: A family fun day, held near the end of the school year, to incorporate health, fitness, and fun. Volunteers will assist with set-up, activity coordination, and clean-up. Time commitment: 1-4 hours behind the scenes and/or day of the event.

FIELD DAY: This event is held during the last week of school in June, and involves fun and physical exercise. Volunteers will assist with set-up, activity coordination, and clean-up. This is the perfect opportunity for a short, one-time commitment to spend time with the kids.
